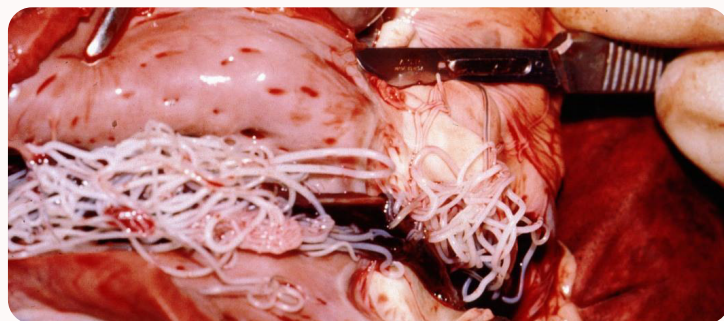

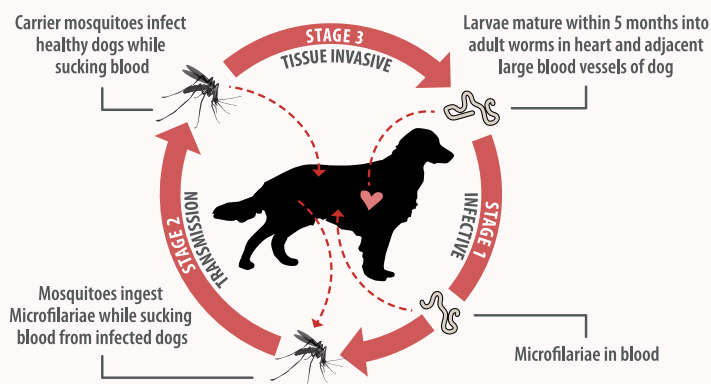
What is Heartworm Disease?

- Immature stages of heartworms live in dog's blood.
- Mosquitoes transmit this disease from one dog to another.



We recommend repelling and killing mosquitoes that may transmit heartworm disease.

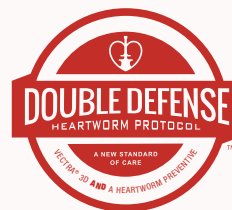
