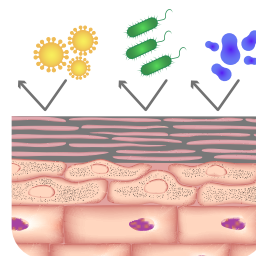

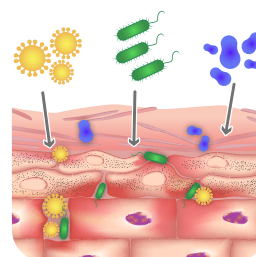
A HEALTHY SKIN BARRIER

HOW TO APPLY YOUR RECOMMENDED PRODUCT

Micellar Solution (Shake well before use. Avoid contact of the applicator's tip with your pet's skin to help avoid contaminating the remaining solution in the bottle.)

For ear cleaning, ask your veterinarian which of the two following protocols is best for your pet:

- ☐ Moisten a cotton ball with solution. Place the moistened cotton ball in the entrance of the ear canal.

OR:

- ☐ Hold the ear flap upwards and fill the ear canal with the solution.

THEN:

Gently massage the base of the ear for 60 seconds. Remove the cotton ball (if used). Allow pet to shake its head. Gently wipe away visible ear wax, debris, and excess solution with a clean, dry cotton ball. Do not use in ruptured eardrum.

To clean other areas of the skin, moisten a cotton ball or gauze with the solution and gently wipe the area to cleanse and remove visible debris. Repeat as often as necessary until clean.
