Repellent effect



- Vectra[®] 3D provides effective monthly prevention and treatment of fleas, ticks, and mosquitoes
- It discourages pests from attaching, biting or feeding
- Helps dogs stay protected from fleas, ticks, mosquitoes, sand flies, biting flies, biting & sucking lice, and mites (excluding mange mites)
- The unique formulation of Vectra[®] 3D causes these parasites to leave the pet and die.

Fleas, Ticks & Mosquitoes

- Fleas
- Repels and kills fleas that may cause flea bite anemia
- Kills fleas including those that may transmit bartonellosis and tapeworm
- Begins reducing flea feeding in 5 minutes
- Monthly use kills all stages of the flea life cycle

- Ticks
 - Repels and kills ticks before they can attach to dogs
 - Repels and kills ticks that may transmit Lyme disease, Rocky Mountain spotted fever, babesiosis, ehrlichiosis, hepatozoonosis, and anaplasmosis
 - Repels and kills ticks that may transmit Lyme disease



- Repels and kills mosquitoes that may transmit heartworm disease

FAQ's:

Why prevent fleas, ticks and mosquitoes from biting?

When an insect is repelled or killed before biting your dog, it doesn't have the opportunity to transmit disease. Mosquitoes transmit heartworm disease, ticks transmit Lyme Disease, fleas transmit disease and cause dermatologic problems as well. Mosquitoes may transmit heartworm disease within a few minutes and ticks may transmit Lyme disease at the first bite.

Why does my dog need topical flea/tick/mosquito prevention?

The American Heartworm Society recommends that in addition to monthly, year-round heartworm prevention, pet owners should also apply a EPA registered mosquito repellent/ectoparasiticide, like Vectra® 3D which has shown to increase the efficacy of a heartworm prevention program.

How should I apply Vectra® 3D to my dog?

Press the discs together to open the applicator tube. To apply at skin level, part the hair at the base of the tail. Squeeze the tube while sliding the tip of the tube towards the head ending at the shoulder blades.
