Meloxidyl® (meloxicam) Injection 5 mg/mL - Repeated use of meloxicam in cats has been associated with acute renal failure and death. Do not administer a second dose of meloxicam in cats. Do not follow meloxicam with any other NSAID in cats. As a class, NSAIDs may be associated with gastrointestinal, kidney, or liver side effects. The most common side effects reported in field studies were vomiting and soft stool/diarrhea. These are usually mild, but may be serious. If side effects occur, pet owners should contact their veterinarian. Pets should be evaluated for pre-existing conditions and currently prescribed medications prior to treatment with MELOXIDYL, then monitored regularly while on treatment. Concurrent use with another NSAID, corticosteroid, or nephrotoxic medication should be avoided. The safe use of MELOXIDYL in dogs younger than 6 months of age, dogs used for breeding, or in pregnant or lactating bitches has not been evaluated. The safe use of MELOXIDYL Injection in cats younger than 4 months of age, cats used for breeding, or pregnant or lactating queens has not been evaluated. Carprodyl® (carprofen) Injection 50 mg/mL - For use in dogs only. Do not use in cats. As a class, NSAIDS may be associated with gastrointestinal, kidney, or liver side effects. The most common side effects reported in field studies were vomiting and soft stool/diarrhea. These are usually mild but may be serious. If side effects occur, pet owners should contact their veterinarian. Pets should be evaluated for pre-existing conditions and currently prescribed medications prior to treatment with CARPRODYL, then monitored regularly while on treatment. Concurrent use with another NSAID or a corticosteroid should be avoided. The safe use of carprofen Injection in animals less than 6 weeks of age, pregnant dogs, dogs used for breeding purposes, or lactating bitches has not been established.
